1. Eligibility Criteria for Open Selection Trials :

1st Asian Games Open Selection Process

The selection trials for the Asian Games will be held in 2 stages at NCOE Kolkata & Sonapat:

10th to 17th Jan'23 – Open Selection Trials

17th to 20th Feb'23 – Closed Selection Trials to be held 45 days before the World Cup Stage 1 in order to submit the entry forms.

Top 24 from the Aug'22 Assessment Trials held at NCOE Sonapat + Archers who have met the Minimum Qualification Score as under in the last 5 months(Sept'22 to Jan'23) in any International Meet abroad or any Championship/Tournament in India or any Nationals/NRAT/University/KI Tournament/State Champ/State Trials.

2. Selection Process & Compound & Recurve Competition Schedule

1st Day – Arrival & Free practice

2nd Day –Event 1 -Qualification Round - All Recurve & Compound Boys & Girl Archers

will be required to shoot 4x70m(Recurve)/4 x 50 M(Compound) @ 6 arrows in 3 min.

After 2 Rds x 70 M/50M archers will be screened down to 32 who shall play the next 2 X 70M/50M to determine the top 24 based on cumulative score.

In case of tie for the last 32nd position, a direct shoot off between the concerned archers to determine the Winner.

In case of tie for the last 24th position, a direct shoot off between the concerned archers to determine the Winner.

At the end of Event 1, top 24 based on cumulative scores of 4 x 70 M/4 x 50 M in each category will proceed to Event – 2.

3rd /4th Day - Event 2 -Ranking Round @ 3 arrows/round – All Recurve & Compound

Men and women archers will be required to shoot 8 x70m(Recurve)/8 x 50 M(Compound)

@3 arrows in 90 Secs i.e. 72 arrows in 1st half and 72 arrows in 2nd half at 70 Mts for Recurve &50 M for Compound@ 3 arrows/90 secs in 2 days to determine the top 16 based on

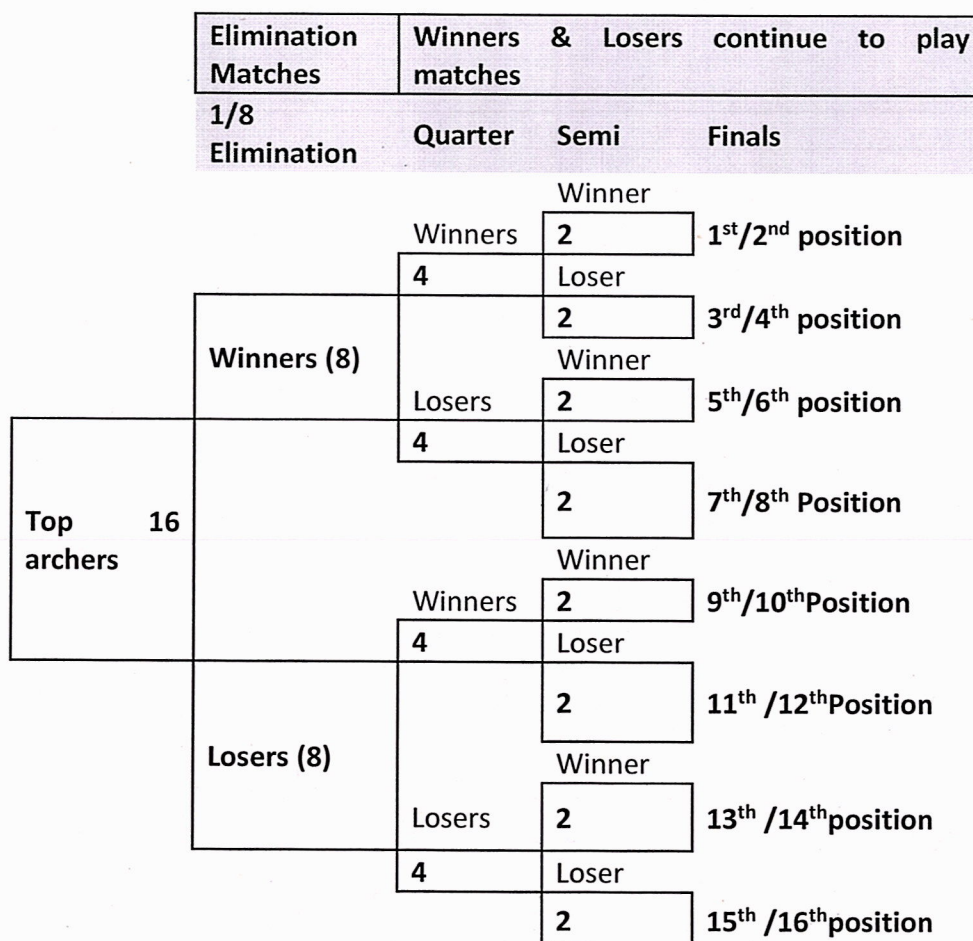
Cumulative score in the Ranking Round.

In case of tie for the 16th position after 8 X 70M/50M, a single arrow shoot off between the concerned archers to determine the Winner.

At the end of Event 2, 16 archers in each category will proceed for Elimination Round. Half day rest shall be given.

5th & 6th Day - Elimination Round – Event 3 - Elimination Round -@ 2 Elimination Round for Top 16 archers. Losers also play matches to rank 1st to 16th archers.

All 16 selected archers shall play 4 matches to rank them from 1st to 16th position. In case there are less than 16 archers then the top archer gets a bye.



For Recurve archers it shall be set score match.

Event 3 - 2nd Elimination Round shall be played in 2nd half based on the new rankings of the 1st Elimination Round to determine 1st to 16th archer.

Point shall be given to the top 16 position as under.

At the end of 2 rounds of 1/8 elimination matches cumulative score added based on points earned and top 8 selected.

For any tie position in the top 16, to determine the higher rank, there will be one arrow shoot off.

For the 8th position in case there is a tie with 9th position there shall be a match or a round robin between the tied Archers to break the tie.

To award the consistency for shooting high the following Bonus Points will be awarded based on cumulative average score shot after all the matches. Archers shall be ranked based on the cumulative average scores and then points given.

The same points shall be given in case archer are tied and then the archer shall be ranked for e.g if there is a tie for the 3rd place by 3 archers then all will be ranked at 3 and the next archer will be ranked at 6th position.

At the end of Event 3, top 8 in each category will proceed to Event – 4 based on total cumulative points- 2 rds of elimination round points + consistency average score points.

6th & 7thDay –Event 4 -Round robin matches for 8 archers and top 4 to be selected.

Archers qualified for Event 4a will be drawn to face each other in round robin format. A win in each match gives an archer +1 point and a loss 0 point.

The Bonus Points and Penalty points for Event 2 shall continue.

At the end of Event 4a, top ranked archer shall get selected and bottom ranked 8th archer shall get eliminated.

If the points of 7th and 8th archer are tied then a match shall be played to resolve the tie. In case there is still a tie, then a one arrow shoot off shall decide the 7th /8th placed archer.

Event 4b : Round Robin league amongst balance 6 archers and at the end top ranked archer shall get selected and bottom ranked 6th archer shall get eliminated. Bonus/Penalty points to be given/taken as mentioned above.

If the points of 5th and 6th archer (for rank 7) are tied then a match shall be played to resolve the tie. In case there is still a tie, then a one arrow shoot off shall decide the 6th (7th rank) place archer.

Event 4c : Round Robin league amongst 4 archers and at the end top ranked archer shall get selected and bottom ranked 4th archer shall get eliminated. Bonus/Penalty points to be given/taken as mentioned above.

If in case there is a tie for top position in Event 4a, 4b,4c there will be a match played between the tied archers to decide the winner. In case there is still a tie, then a one arrow shoot off shall decide the higher placed archer.

If the points of last two 3rd and 4th archers(for rank 6th) are tied then a match shall be played to resolve the tie. In case there is still a tie, then a one arrow shoot off shall decide the 6th place archer.

For the 4th position (last position of the Team) cumulative points of Event 4a, 4b and 4c shall be added between the 2nd and 3rd ranked archer(of event 4 c). If the points of both/all the three archers are tied then a match shall be played to resolve the tie. In case there is still a tie, then a one arrow shoot off shall decide the 4th place archer.

2nd AG TRIALS

The 2nd AG Trials shall start from 1/8 Elimination Round based on the ranking of top 16 archers from 1st Open AG Trials since already top 16 archers selected and tested out based on 6 arrows round and 3 arrow round.

Archers will play 2 ends of elimination round and the process followed will be same as of 1st AG Trials.

Top 8 archers from the Elimination Round shall move into the Round Robin Matches and the archers ranked from 1st to 8th and top 4 archers selected in India A team.

Note for Non performance :

Non performance is as under :

- **Individual** : If any archer does not go to the top 16 of the World Cup i.e. Pre quarter finals. He loses out in the Elimination first (1/64 or 1/32) and second round (1/16) itself.
- **Team** : If the team (top 3 playing archers) **does not reach the semi final(Top 4)**.
- **Team** : 4th Player (non playing in the team) shall be treated as individual and has to ensure top 16 position in the Elimination Round.
- If in case any of the selected archer's performance is below par as mentioned above **IN ANY OF THE World Cups Stage 1, 2 and 3** then we shall have a round robin match between the archer and the 5th to 8th archer of the second selection trials held in Feb'23 to determine the replacement of the non performing archer.

The selection trials shall take place in end May'23 after the World Cup Stage 2 and in end June after the World Cup Stage 3.

For sake of entry for the Asian Games in case the last date is 31st May'23 then we shall send the names after the May'23 trials and for the World Championship after the June'23 trials.

In case the Asian Games is not held then the Core Committee has the right to have a fresh trials for the Asian Championship.

Core Committee of AAI has the right to make changes in the selection trials as required based on the situation.
